A volunteer is required to help a person we support with social outings and some beauty care i.e. painting nails etc. We would like someone to do between 2 and 4 hours per week and this can be on any day.

Experience of people with an intellectual disability with behaviours that challenge is essential. Some experience of dealing with seizures would be good. Ideally someone with a Social Care qualification is needed. Some intimate care duties may be required. The volunteer must have a good sense of humour.

This role would suit a Social Care / Social Science graduate seeking experience to apply for a Masters. It is very relevant to anyone seeking experience in a community support role.
