

Teacher/Tutor (Literacy) - Mallow Day Service

We need volunteers to teach young adults on a one to one/small group basis a range of basic functional literacy skills for example: reading, writing, spelling, punctuation, letter writing, form filling, counting and basic math skills.

Ideally these volunteers will have experience or a background in teaching or be a trained adult literacy tutor. Some experience of working with people with learning difficulties would be an advantage but not essential. The Parish Centre in Mallow will run a 6 week Literacy Course for any volunteer who has not had previous training.

Volunteers are required for various time slots from Monday to Friday 10am to 3.30pm.

These sessions will be on going & long term in nature so a commitment of at least 6 months is required. Volunteers will be based in the Day Centre, Quartertown, Mallow.

This is a great opportunity for someone who wants experience in the area of teaching and working with people who have learning difficulties.
