A volunteer is needed to support a young man to take part in recreational activities and to encourage him to try out new activities and to make choices regarding his social activities/interests.

The volunteer needs to be patient and encouraging with an outgoing personality and needs to be able to allow individuals to make their own choices. This role will be community based in the city centre.

The volunteer should be interested in sports & physical activities, running, walking etc. and have an outgoing personality. Some experience of people with autism is desirable.

We would ideally like someone to do 4 hours per week over 2 time slots but will be glad of 2 hours per week also. The most suitable times currently are Monday or Weds afternoon or Tues mornings.

A minimum commitment of 6 months is required for this role. Induction and initial training will be provided.
